Amendments to Notice of Race

1 RULES

1.5 Add: 1.5 For Circle **2** and ILCA sailors, Rule 40.1 (**PFDs Required**) will be in effect. Note that Flag "Y" may not be displayed. This changes Rule 40.2 All other skippers and crew are encouraged to wear PFDs.

6 SCHEDULE OF RACES

- 6.1 The schedule of races shall be amended as follows: (Changes in *underlined bold italics*).
 - 6.1 Friday, September 22nd
 - 4:30pm Junior boat assignment <u>and inspection</u>, practice, and pizza party for participants

Saturday, September 23rd

- 8:30-9:45am: Regatta check-in *and boat inspection* (north side of Lakeview [LVC])
- 10:00am: Skipper's Meeting (south side of LVC, on patio)
- 11:00am: First signal
- 4:00pm: Latest allowed start signal
- 4:00-7:00pm: Post-Race Party (LVC Food Truck and live music)

Sunday, September 24th

• 8:30-9:45am: Regatta check-in (north side LVC)

- 10:30am: First signal
- 3:00pm: Latest allowed start signal
- 3:30pm: (Or as soon as Jr. racing concludes) JUNIOR Regatta Awards/Troph Presentation (LVC patio)
- 5:00pm: ADULT Regatta Awards/Trophy Presentation (on LVC patio May if racing concludes early)

10 CHARTERED OR LOANED BOATS

10.2 Add: 10.2 It is the SOLE responsibility of the skipper to check the condition of the boat in advance of racing, whether it is personally-owned or chartered. Pre-existing hull or rig damage, missing parts, defective equipment or gear failure during the regatta shall not constitute grounds for redress.

Amendments to Sailing Instructions

16 TIME LIMITS

- 16.1 Amended as follows: The <u>Finish</u> time limits are:
 15 minutes after the first boat finishes for Circle 1, 10 minutes for Circle 2.
- Add: 16.2 Boats <u>not</u> finishing within the Finish Time Limit will be scored "TLE" without a hearing. This changes Rules 35, A4 and A5
- Add: 16.3 For Circle 2 only, the Race Time Limits for each race shall be 40 minutes for courses "W" and "T" and 50 minutes for courses "W2", "T2", "G" and "GT"

18 SCORING

- Add: 18.2 When 4 or fewer races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total her races scored. When 5-8 races have been completed, it will be the total of her races scored excluding her worst score. When 9 or more races have been completed, it will be the total of her races scored excluding her 2 worst scores.
- Add: 18.3 Rule A5.3 will apply. (DNF boats will be scored as the number of boats checked in for the start of the day +1)
- 18.4 Add: 18.4 Boats scored "TLE" as described in 16.2 of this amendment shall be scored as the number of finishers +1

23 Add: 23 SUPPORT, COACHING AND COACH BOATS

- All coaches and support boats shall register at the Check In table prior to the competitors' meeting
- 23.2 Team leaders, coaches and other support personnel shall stay outside areas where boats are rac from the time of the preparatory signal until all boats have finished the race or the race commit signals a postponement, general recall or abandonment.

24 Add: 24 RECALLS

As a courtesy, the race committee will attempt to hail On Course Side (OCS) boats. Failure to execute this hail or failure to receive it shall not relieve a boat or her sole obligation to start properly, nor shall it constitute an improper action or omission of the race committee under RF 62.1(a)

25 Add: 25 QUAGGA MUSSEL CERTIFICATION

All Watercraft (Coach, Spectator, Charter and Competitor) must certify and are subject to inspection in compliance with the State of Utah 2023 Mussel Aware Boater program.
