## NOTICE OF RACE 2016 *SkiGatta*

March 19<sup>th</sup> and 20<sup>th</sup> 2016  
(Jordanelle Reservoir & Deer Valley, Park City, Utah)

### 1) Rules:

- a) The event will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing 2013-2016, NASTAR and this Notice of Race, except as may be amended by the Competitor Instructions or any appendices thereto.
- b) The organizing authority is the Park City Sailing Association.
- c) The regatta is designated Category C in accordance with RRS Appendix 1, ISAF Regulation 20.
- d) A PFD must be worn while on the water at all times.

### 2) Eligible Classes:

- a) Laser / Laser Radial / Laser 4.7 (Scored together)

### 3) Inspection and Measurement:

- a) Laser Class rules shall apply unless amended in this NOR or SI's.
- b) Sails and equipment may be measured prior to racing, and may be spot checked at any time during the regatta.
- c) A Laser practice sail of similar dimensions & shape may be substituted for Laser Class legal sails.

### 4) Eligibility and Entry:

- a) A minimum of three entries are required to constitute a class.

### 5) Risk:

- a) It is, at all times, the decision of the competitor whether or not to enter the event and/or to start or continue any race. By registering in the event, the competitor agrees to assume all risks associated with participation in the event and will hold harmless Park City Sailing Association, its members and volunteers for any damages that might arise from participating in the event.
- b) Wetsuits or dry suits are strongly recommended.

## 7) **Registration:**

- a) Register on line at [www.sailpc.org](http://www.sailpc.org)
- b) Entry & Fees:
  - i) \$150 paid online with registration
  - ii) Entry fee includes one ticket for dinner on Saturday night, ski pass, 4 NASTAR runs and SkiGatta belt buckle. You must register by March 13<sup>th</sup> to guarantee a buckle.
  - iii) Additional tickets for Saturday's diner can be purchased online for \$30 per head.

8) **Sailing Instructions.** Sailing instructions will be available on the Park City Sailing Association web site and at on-site registration.

## 9) **Courses & Racing Area:**

- a) Courses will be windward-leeward and/or triangle of an appropriate length as determined by the RC.
- b) The racing area will be on the Jordanelle Reservoir approximately one quarter of a mile south of the Personal Watercraft Ramp.

## 10) **Scoring:**

- a) Sailing: the Low Point Scoring System, Appendix A2, will be used. Competitors will be ranked 1-X based on results from the Low Point Scoring System.
- b) A minimum of one race must be completed to score the sailing portion of the Skigatta.
- c) Skiing:
  - i) Competitors will make 4 runs.
  - ii) Run 1 and 3 will be on one course and Run 2 and 4 will be on the second course (assuming 2 courses are open). If only one course is open, all 4 runs will be on that course.
  - iii) Slowest timed run will be discarded and 3 fastest timed runs will be added together to rank competitors 1-X on a cumulative time basis.
  - iv) Overall rankings will be decided by adding the competitors sailing rank with the skiing rank. Ties will be broken by who beat who in the sailing portion of the event.

11) **Prizes:** will be awarded.

12) **Charters:** may be available on a limited basis from fleet members not participating in the racing. Please contact Geoff at [parkcitylasersailing@yahoo.com](mailto:parkcitylasersailing@yahoo.com) to inquire about available boats.

13) **Hospitality:** Competitors and their guests are invited to use park facilities on race days. Refreshments will be available following racing on Saturday and Sunday. There will be a dinner on Saturday night. Guests of competitors may purchase additional dinner tickets.

14) **Pets:** The Jordanelle welcomes pets but they must be on leashes at all times.
