NOTICE OF RACE 2018 Park City Sailing Fall Regatta

September 29 – 30, 2018

Organizing Authority: Park City Sailing Association Jordanelle Reservoir, Park City, Utah

1. Rules

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing 2017-2020 and this Notice Of Race, except as any of these are changed by the Sailing Instructions or any appendices to the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.2. Class rules shall apply for each division unless changed by this NOR or amended in the SI.

2. Eligible Classes

- 2.1. Lasers/Laser Radial District 23 Championships
- 2.2. 420s
- 2.3. Optimist
- 2.4. Elliott 6meter
- 2.5. Ultimate 20
- 2.6. Open Keelboats (PHRF)
- 2.7. Open Catamarans (PHRF)
- 2.8. Open Dinghies (PHRF)

3. Inspection and Measurement

3.1. Sails and equipment may be measured prior to racing, and may also be spot checked at any time during the regatta. Since this event is serving as the Laser District 23 Championships, the Laser and Laser Radial division, class legal sails will be required (no practice sails).

4. Eligibility and Entry

- 4.1. A minimum of three entries are required to constitute a class.
- 4.2. Competitors may register eligible classes on-line at: www.SAILPC.org

5. Disclaimer of Liability

5.1. It is the competitor's decision to enter the regatta and to start or continue any race. The competitors are ultimately responsible for the risks. The competitor will accept full responsibility for all his/her actions during any activity related to the event. This includes on-shore activities before, during, and after the regatta.

7. Fees

7.1. Required Fees (checks should be made payable to: Park City Sailing Association) A \$15 late fee charge will be made for registration after September 17th. Charters are available on a first come first serve basis at an additional cost.

Class	Fee
Laser	\$50 (1 party ticket), \$50 charter (limited #'s)
Elliot 6m	\$120 racing (3 party tickets), \$120 for charter
Open Class Keel Boats	\$120 (3 party tickets), \$75 for R19 charter
420, Open Dinghy, Catamarans	\$60 racing (2 party tickets) + \$60 for 420 charter
Optimist	\$40 (1 party ticket) + \$40 Optimist charter

7.2. The entry fee includes dinner on Saturday night for competitors.

8. Sailing Instructions

8.1. Preliminary sailing instructions will be available on the Park City Sailing Association web site on or about September 22, 2018. A final version will be available at on-site registration.

9. Courses & Racing Area

- 9.1. Courses will be Windward Leeward of an appropriate length
- 9.2. The racing area will be on the Jordanelle Reservoir approx. one quarter mile South of the Personal Watercraft Ramp.

10. Scoring

- 10.1. The Low Point Scoring System, Appendix A, will be used.
- 10.2. Seven races are scheduled, and a minimum of three races must be completed to constitute a regatta.
- 10.3. Open classes will race on a handicapped PHRF system. All other divisions will be scored as one-design.

11. Additional Information

- 11.1. Accommodation. Jordanelle State Park has camping sites available to rent for the event (435-649-9540): Closest hotels: Peaks Park City-\$69(roughly) (800.649.5012); Park City Marriot -\$\$ (800-234-9003) Reserve early.
- 11.2. Charters. Charters will be available on a limited basis through members of the fleet not participating in the racing and/or PCSA owned Optis, 420 and Elliot 6m. Please contact Geoff at geoff.hurwitch@parkcitysailing org to inquire about available boats.
- 11.3. Park Access: Standard park access fees are in effect during the regatta and are the responsibility of competitors to pay when entering the park.
- 11.4. Hospitality. Competitors and their guests are invited to use park facilities on race days. Refreshments will be available following racing on Saturday and Sunday. There will be a dinner on Saturday night. Guests of competitors may purchase additional dinner tickets.
- 11.5. Pets. The Jordanelle does welcome pets but they must be on leashes at all times.
- 11.6. Re-usable water bottles recommended. Water refill stations will be available.

12. Prizes.

12.1. Prizes will be awarded to the top boats in each division as fleet sizes allow.

1st Place – 3 or more boats 2nd Place – 5 or more boats

3rd Place – 7 or more boats
